About the Brentwood Library

The Brentwood Library has grown tremendously since it was established by the city in 1983.

The library moved into its current 55,500-square-foot building on Concord Road in 1998.

The Brentwood Library has been recognized as one of the premier public libraries in Tennessee. It is one of the busiest as well, with more than **1,000 visitors daily**.


Last year, **678,533** items were circulated and **373,897** patrons visited the library.

The library offered **399** children's programs, and **13,152** children attended. There were **390** teen and adult programs attended by **4,853**people.

The library's attributes include the awardwinning building designed by Nashville architect David Minnigan, a renowned children's reading room and a 40-acre, park-like setting.

The City of Brentwood provides 97 percent of the operating budget.
